### Ward Priorities

#### 1. Road Safety

- There have been no reports regarding road safety issues over the past month.

#### 2. Antisocial Behaviour

- Overnight between 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> April 2018, the parking meter at Gullane Bents was damaged. Unfortunately, there are no positive lines of enquiry.
- During the evening of 4<sup>th</sup> May 2018, a female was arrested in Main Street, Gullane after causing a disturbance on a bus. She was charged with breach of the peace, Police assault and possession of cannabis.
- In the evening of 13<sup>th</sup> May 2018, Police received a complaint of loud music coming from a house at Muirfield Gardens, Gullane. All was quiet on Police arrival.

#### 3. Housebreaking

- Overnight between 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> April 2018, a break in occurred to the farm shop at Fenton Barns retail park. No items were taken. During the same night, several shipping containers at Fenton Barns had their padlocks cut and were entered but nothing was stolen.
- During the early hours of 8<sup>th</sup> May 2018, 4 youths were arrested and charged with breaking into the CO-OP, Main Street, Gullane, whereby a quantity of alcohol, food and cigarettes were stolen.
- Overnight between 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2018, a break-in occurred to Drem timber whereby a quantity of cash and tools were stolen. Enquiries are still ongoing.

#### 4. Parking

- During the month of April 2018, 54 parking tickets were issued in Gullane by East Lothian Council Parking attendants. No tickets were issued in Aberlady. This figure includes the coastal car park area of Yellowcraigs.

### Other Incidents of note / relevant Community Council information

- During the afternoon of 03/05/18, the driver of a vehicle being driven in Gullane was stopped and issued with a Recorded Policing Warning regarding the possession of cannabis.
- During the day on 18<sup>th</sup> May 2018, a vehicle was broken into in Saltcoates Road, Gullane and a set of golf clubs and trolley stolen.
- On 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2018, Police received a report regarding an assault having taken place within Greywalls Hotel, Gullane. Enquiries are ongoing.
- During the day on 17<sup>th</sup> May 2018, a call was received from a resident of Aberlady stating that a male had been knocking on doors and attempting to sell goods. A further call was received later that day regarding several other males selling goods around doors in Gullane. 3 males were traced by Police and are being reported to The Procurator Fiscal for selling goods without a valid pedlars certificate.
