1. Road Safety

Other Incidents of note / relevant Community Council information

- During the morning of 11th July 2018, a male was arrested in Hall Crescent, Gullane for driving under the influence of drugs and driving without insurance. He was also found in possession of a large quantity of diamorphine.
- Overnight between 16th and 19th July, 2018, 5 conifer plants were stolen from various tubs in the Main Street, Gullane. Enquiries are still ongoing.
- Overnight between 21st and 22nd July 2018, a wing mirror from a vehicle parked in Hamilton Road, Gullane was damaged. Enquiries are still ongoing.
- Overnight between 21st and 22nd July 2018, a wing mirror and rear wiper blade were also removed from a vehicle parked in Lammerview Terrace, Gullane. Enquiries are also still ongoing.
- In the early hours of 25th July 2018, a large quantity of rolls were stolen from outside The Aberlady Store, Aberlady. Enquiries are ongoing to trace a vehicle which may have been involved in the theft.
