During the period of the last report there have been several incidents of note.

I am aware that there may be more incidents but, due to the nature of these, or ongoing investigations, I cannot give full details.

They are broken down in terms of the agreed priorities for the ward.

Ward Priorities

1. Road Safety

- During the early hours of the morning on 6/11/18, a vehicle failed to stop for Police in the Gullane area. It was eventually traced in the village. Driver charged with not having the vehicle insured, possession of controlled drugs and various other road traffic offences.
- On 22/11/18, Police received several reports regarding a vehicle driving in a dangerous manner on the Drem to Camptoun road. The driver was later traced by Police, charged accordingly and a report has been sent to the Procurator Fiscal.

2. Antisocial Behaviour

- Over the past month, several complaints to Police and East Lothian Council have been received in relation to noise complaints from a property in Muirfield Terrace, Gullane. The occupier there has been issued with a warning letter by East Lothian Council's Anti-Social Behaviour Team.

3. Housebreaking

- There have been no reports of housebreaking in the area over the past month.

4. Parking

- During the month of September 2018, 20 parking tickets were issued in Aberlady, 48 in Gullane and 66 in Yellowcraigs by East Lothian Parking attendants.

CAPP

The date of the next CAPP meeting is on Wednesday 28th November 2018, 1930 hours, Council Chambers, North Berwick. The agreed priorities from the previous meeting were:

1. Halloween and Bonfire Night patrols and Anti-social behaviour related prevention.
2. High Visibility patrols in the ward area as a result of recent break-in's/theft of vehicles.
3. Speed checks on A198 in towns.

Other Incidents of note / relevant Community Council information

- During the early hours of 31/10/18, a large quantity of rolls were stolen from outside The CO-OP, Main Street, Gullane. A male responsible was subsequently traced and issued with a recorded Police Warning for the theft.
- Between 20/11/18 and 21/11/18, the parking ticket machine at Gullane Bents has been damaged. Enquiries are ongoing.
- During the 21/11/18 a fake £50 was passed by an unknown person in The CO-OP, Main Street, Gullane. Several other CO-OP's within the East Lothian area were also subject to this also. Enquiries are ongoing.
