I am aware that there may be more incidents but, due to the nature of these, or ongoing investigations, I cannot give full details.

They are broken down in terms of the agreed priorities for the ward.

Ward Priorities

1. Road Safety

- There are no road safety issues to report.

2. Antisocial Behaviour

- On 10th January 2019, a female was issued with a fixed penalty ticket for a breach of the peace as a result of an incident in Muirfield Terrace, Gullane.

3. Housebreaking

- There have been no reports of housebreaking over the past 2 months.

4. Parking

- The number of parking tickets issued for the area is currently unavailable.

CAPP

The date of the next CAPP meeting is on Wednesday 20th February 2019, 1930 hours, Council Chambers, North Berwick. The agreed priorities from the previous meeting were:

1. Parking around school areas in the ward.
2. Irresponsible parking in North Berwick.
3. Dog fouling in Gullane.

Other Incidents of note / relevant Community Council information

- Between 29th and 30th November 2018, an insecure vehicle was entered in Muirfield Grove, Gullane and a lap-top, ipad and wallet were stolen from within. Enquiries are still ongoing.
- Between 29th and 30th November 2018, a further 2 insecure vehicle were entered whilst parked in Muirfield Grove, Gullane, however, nothing was stolen from either vehicle.
- Between 29th and 30th November 2018, a vehicle was broken into in Muirfield Gardens, Gullane and a sports holdall stolen from within. Enquiries are still ongoing.
- Overnight between 29th and 30th November 2018, entry was gained to an insecure vehicle parked in Muirfield Gardens and a purse and bag stolen from within. Enquiries are still ongoing.
- Between 29th and 30th November 2018, a set of windscreen wipers were stolen from a vehicle parked in Muirfield Gardens, Gullane. Enquiries are still ongoing.
- Between 29th and 30th November 2018, a further 2 insecure vehicles were entered in Goose Green Road, Gullane, however, nothing was stolen from either vehicle.
- Between 29th and 30th November 2018, an insecure shed was entered in Muirfield Gardens, Gullane however, nothing was stolen from within.
- Between 30th November 2018 and 1st December 2018, an insecure portacabin at Congalton Market Gardens was entered and a leaf blower and strimmer stolen from within. Enquiries are ongoing.
- During the morning of 20th December, staff members from Pure Malt Products, Fenton Barns reported the theft of metal from their site and a possible vehicle which was connected. The vehicle was later stopped by Police and both driver and passenger arrested. Both were charged with theft of metal and driver also charged with other driving offences and misuse of drugs offences.
- During the evening of 3rd January 2019, a male was found in possession of cannabis within number 3 carpark, Longniddy Bents.
- During the evening on 7th January 2019, a male entered the CO-OP, Gullane and tendered a fake Bank of England £50 note. Images were captured on cctv and enquiries are ongoing to identify the male.
- Overnight between 23rd and 24th January 2019, 2 vehicles were damaged outside a property in Ruthven Road, Dirleton. Enquiries are still ongoing.
