### Ward Priorities

#### 1. Road Safety

- Numerous reports of vehicles parking on the road to West Fenton
- On the 4<sup>th</sup> of June a call was received regarding cars parked on and near to the junction outside Drem railway station, Police attended no offences were detected but ELC have been contacted re lines on the road.
- Overnight 5<sup>th</sup> of June a vehicle was damaged whilst parked in the High Street Aberlady a crime report for a hit and run vehicle accident has been submitted enquiries are ongoing.

#### 2. Antisocial Behaviour

- During the early hours of Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> June, a noise complaint was received regarding a property in Gullane. Unfortunately police were unable to attend due to higher graded calls. Local Community Officers made aware of call.
- On 9<sup>th</sup> June 2019, at approx. 1300 hours, on West Links Road, Gullane, a cyclist was assaulted by a male in a passing motor car. Details taken from complainer and enquiries ongoing to trace driver of vehicle.
- On the evening of 15<sup>th</sup> June 2019 a call was received about a large group of youths in Goose Green Road it was suspected by the informant that they had been at a beach party, on Police arrival 30 minutes later there was no trace of the youths.
