During the period of the last report there have been several incidents of note.

I am aware that there may be more incidents but, due to the nature of these, or ongoing investigations, I cannot give full details.

They are broken down in terms of the agreed priorities for the ward.

Ward Priorities

1. Road Safety

- On Saturday 31st August, between 1000 and 1030 hours, a pro-active speed check was carried out on the A198, Aberlady. Majority of vehicle driving at an appropriate speed. One driver verbally warned.

2. Antisocial Behaviour

- In the evening of Friday 6th September, a fence in the rear garden at Stanley Road, Gullane was damaged. Possibly connected to the break in to the shed on the same night as properties are next to each other. Enquiries ongoing.
- On Sunday 15th September, Police were called to a report of a male exposing himself at Aberlady beach. Police were unable to trace the male however after speaking to witnesses it would appear to be a drunk male, urinating as opposed to direct exposure. He was fully clothed and seen falling about the grassy area. Full search of area however male not traced.
- On the evening of 20th September youths were reported to be "playing chad door and run" 2 separate calls were received by Police. On Police arrival, no youths were traced.
- On 21st September a noise complaint was reported from Yellowcraigs Car Park. A black Audi was playing loud music. The complaint was passed to the ELC noise team

3. Housebreaking

- Sometime between the 17th and 28th August, a garage was broken into at West Fenton, Gullane. A large number of tools were stolen. Nothing seen or heard, no CCTV in the area. Enquiries ongoing.
- In the evening of Friday 6th September, a shed at the rear of The Bonnie Badger in Gullane was broken into by youths. Paint and a leaf blower were stolen however recovered a short time later nearby. Police attended and traced a number of youths a short distance away, where all details were noted. CCTV to be viewed to identify youths responsible.
- Between 1330 and 1845 hours on Thursday 5th September, the barn at Bankhead near Whitekirk was entered and a dark green Artic Car RT3 Quad was stolen along with 2 chainsaws and a Stihl saw. Enquiries ongoing at this time.
