### Ward Priorities

#### 1. Road Safety

- Numerous calls regarding vehicles causing an obstruction at Muirfield Drive, Gullane. Police aware of issues and giving passing attention to the area.

#### 2. Antisocial Behaviour

- On Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> October, it was reported to police that the side of a house in Aberlady was vandalised by being spray painted. Enquiries ongoing.

#### 3. Housebreaking

- It has been reported to police on 1<sup>st</sup> November that sometime in the last week of October, a garage was broken in to at a property at Ballencrieff Steading. 2 Mountain bikes were stolen from within. Enquiries ongoing.
- Between midnight and 0730 hours on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> November, a property near to Luffness Mains, Aberlady was broken into and 2 bikes were stolen. The first is a Specialised Roubaix Road Bike and the second a Specialised Stump Jumper Mountain Bike. Enquiries ongoing.

#### 4. Parking – October 2019 issued by ELC

- Aberlady - 1 PCN's (1 outside Nature Reserve)
- Gullane - 2 PCN's + 27 PCN's at Gullane Bents
- Yellowcraigs - 27 PCN's at Yellowcraigs

### Other Incidents of note / relevant Community Council information

- Police received a report of a sculpture which has been stolen from inside Gosford House sometime in October. Details taken and enquiries to be made.
- In the evening of Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> November, whilst on routine patrol of Longniddry Bents Car Park 3, a smell of drugs was detected emanating from a vehicle, the passenger was found in possession of cannabis and received a recordable police warning for possession of a controlled drug.
- Between 1400 and 1545 hours on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> November, a green Land Rover Defender was stolen from Redside Farm Steadings. Police attended and enquiries are ongoing.
- In the morning of Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> November, a white ford transit was stopped near Fenton Barns, male driver searched and found in possession of drugs. Charged with possession of drugs.
- In the evening of Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> November, within Longniddry car park, police were on mobile patrol when they observed a vehicle with a male inside acting suspicious. When police approached the vehicle the male made an attempt to make off. Male cautioned and charged with sexual indecent exposure.
- On Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> November, police were made aware of a 1 car vehicle accident near Drem where the vehicle was off the road on near side into ditch and half under water. Male driver out of vehicle. Police attended, along with SAS and Fire. Driver failed roadside breath test. Male charged with drink driving.
- During the month there have been several reports of person's hare coursing in the ward area, if these persons are seen, police to be contacted and descriptions of persons, dogs and vehicle passed.
