### Ward Priorities

#### 1. Road Safety

- On Monday 28<sup>th</sup> September, police were called to a 2 car minor injury VA at Ballencrieff. A female was reported for careless driving.
- In the afternoon of Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> October, a 2 car road traffic collision occurred where 1 person was taken to ERI for a possible broken arm.
- In the evening of Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> October, a call was received regarding a car on its roof near to Longniddry Bents. Police attended where no persons were found in or around the vehicle. Thorough search conducted with negative result. Check of vehicle revealed no insurance, tax or MOT. Enquiries ongoing to trace driver.

#### 2. Antisocial Behaviour

- On Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> September, there was a report of a male acting aggressively in Main Street, Gullane. Police attended however no trace of male.
- On Monday 28<sup>th</sup> September, police were called to Station Road, Dirlerton to a female lying in the middle of the road refusing to move. Police attended, and conveyed female back home.
- On the evening of Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> October, at Hall Crescent, Gullane, a report of youths within skip dragging items from it causing a mess was received. Police attended however no trace of youths or a mess on arrival.

### Other Incidents of note / relevant Community Council information

- In the afternoon of Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> September, police were called to a 1 car VA on the B1347, where a car has come off the road into an embankment and crashed into a wall. Police attended. No injuries, no offences and details exchanged with landowner.
- A call was received in the afternoon of Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> September reporting syringes were lying behind a log at Longniddry Beach. Information passed onto Community Wardens at East Lothian Council.
- A pop up policeman designed to reduce speeding has been stolen from Drem
- Between 27<sup>th</sup> September overnight into Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> September, three large wooden planters were stolen from Gullane. Enquiries ongoing.
- On 29<sup>th</sup> September, EOD attended a section of beach at Broadsands, Yellowcraig and successfully detonated 10 x 20mm anti aircraft rounds after a member of public had reported finding them.
- In the morning of Monday 5<sup>th</sup> October, a member of the public disturbed 2 males believed to be deer coursing with dogs in the Dirleton area. Extensive area search carried out with no trace of males. Details taken and enquiries ongoing.
- In the evening of Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> October, whilst police were on routine mobile patrol at Longniddry Bents, a male was searched after a smell of cannabis was detected from within his vehicle. Male was found to be in possession of a small amount of cannabis. Recordable Police Warning issued.
- In the evening of Monday 12<sup>th</sup> October, at Longniddry Bents, a recordable police warning was issued after a positive drugs search.
- Between 1900 on the 9<sup>th</sup> October and 0700 on the 12<sup>th</sup> October, slabs have been taken from the outside path at Fenton Barns Nursery. Enquiries ongoing.
- In the morning of Monday 26<sup>th</sup> October, police were called to a suspected Hare Coursing near Gullane. Police attended and located a vehicle with 2 lurcher dogs where 2 men inside the vehicle were spoken to, their details taken and checked out. The vehicle and area were searched but no sign of hare coursing. The dogs were checked over with no sign of injuries.
